Dear Certification Bodies,

It has been observed that the domestic as well as export Transaction Certificates are being issued months after the consignment has been exported. The CBs are required to maintain standard procedures and timelines for issuing TCs. Therefore, You are requested to follow the procedure given below :

1. The request for T.C should be made by the operator before the consignment is dispatched and the actual T.C should be issued within 30days after the shipment details are provided by the exporter so that the TC reaches the importer before t before the consignment reaches the port.
2. Domestic T.C within seven days of the request and should be accompanied with the Product.
