Dear Certification Bodies,

It has been observed that Transaction Certificates once issued are being cancelled by the Certification Bodies due to various reasons even after a few months. The rationale mentioned in Tracenet for cancellation of TCs are irrelevant and cannot be considered appropriate. Such lapses by the CBs is resulting in appropriate data for the entire year of production, volume of export.

Since the CBs are given a provision for previewing the TC before printing, the present provision for cancellation of Transaction Certificate is withdrawn by APEDA with effect from tomorrow.

Therefore, CBs are required to double check the information fed in Transaction Certificate during reviewing the preview before issuing the same.
